

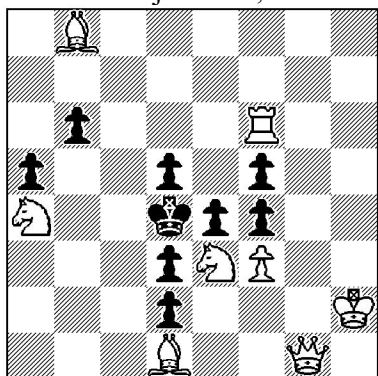
## Haji Mammadov / Hacı Məmmədov / Гаджи Мамедов (23.05.1954 – 18.11.2020)

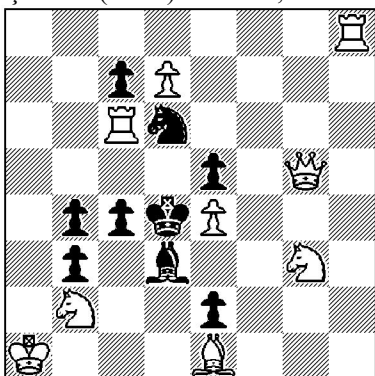

Şahmat (Baku) 1988-89, 2<sup>nd</sup> HM

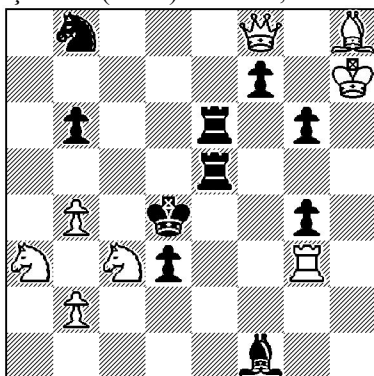

Şahmat (Baku) 1990-91, 1<sup>st</sup> Prize

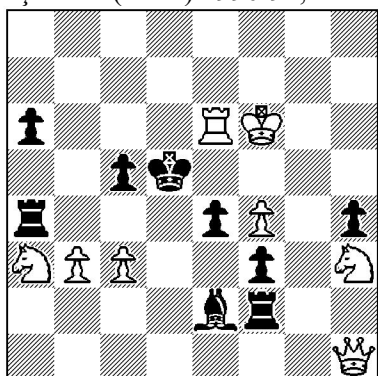

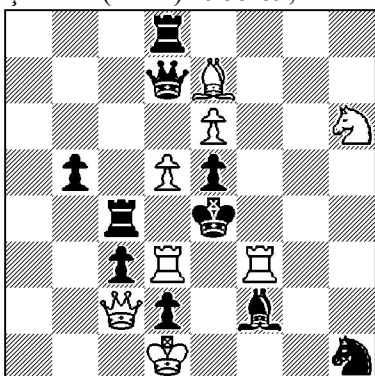

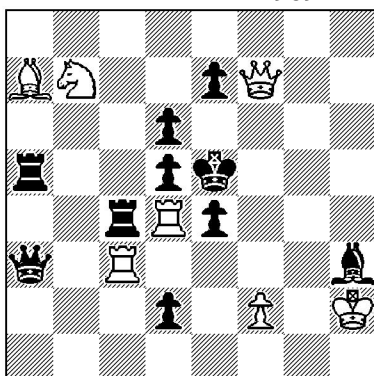

Za kommunizm 1989

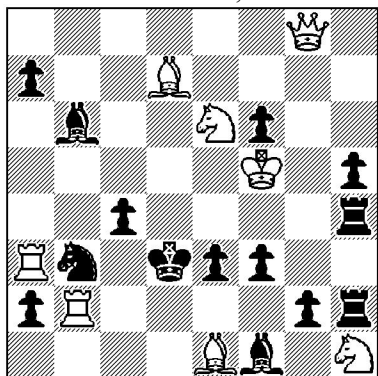

StrateGems 2008, 2<sup>nd</sup> HM

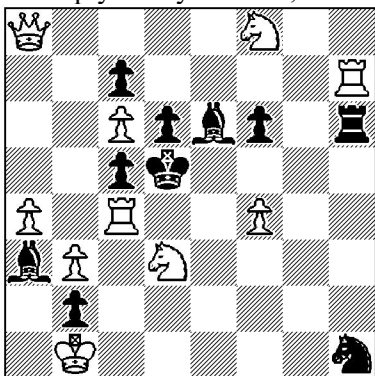

Olimpiya dünyası 2008, HM

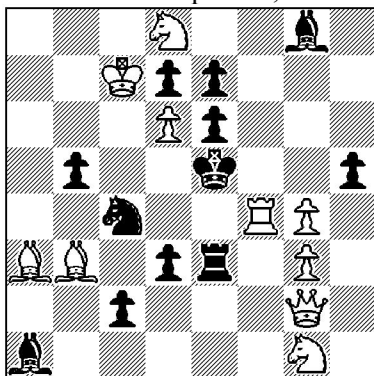
